# Little Nancy Creek Park and Park Pride

**Little Nancy Creek Park** is a five-acre tract, on Peachtree Dunwoody Road at Winall Down Road, which the City of Atlanta purchased in 2007. Although the site is being prepared for improvements, much work needs to happen before it becomes a 'world-class park'. So, the **Friends of Little Nancy Creek Park** group have just kicked-off a 6-8 month process to envision improvements to this park.

**Little Nancy Creek Park** was selected to participate in **Park Pride's** Park Visioning Program and receive master planning assistance for the park. Walt Ray, Director of Park Visioning for Park Pride, will guide area residents through a series of Public Meetings as advertised in this flyer. These meetings are open to all interested residents from North Buckhead, Brookhaven and other area neighborhoods. During this collaborative process, residents are invited to examine the existing conditions of the park, and determine what park uses may serve the community better. While raising simple questions as presented in this survey, a dialogue can begin to generate a conceptual master plan that will be used as a guide for future construction and fund raising efforts, as well as for steering the development of Little Nancy Creek Park for years to come.
