Paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All paper products (except boxes/paper with food contamination)• Shredded paper in a clear plastic bag• NO paper towels or tissues
Glass	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All bottles and jars (rinse; remove the lids)
Cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Aluminum cans and Steel (tin) cans
Plastics	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All hard plastic food containers and plastic bottles # 1-7 (please rinse)• NO plastic bags, NO hoses or wire, NO plastic pipes, NO plastic furniture, NO Styrofoam
Cardboard	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Broken down or cut to fit in the bin. Keep it Dry. (NO STYROFOAM)

All recyclables are placed together in the bin and are separated for recycling at the processing facility.
